### GOALS AND PRIZES

#### Reading Goals

Individual reading goals are based upon grade levels. The individual reading goals are as follows:

Grade Level Reading Goal	Bronze Medal Goal 	Silver Medal Goal 	Gold Medal Goal 
Kindergarten	225	400	800+
1 <sup>st</sup> Grade	300	450	900+
2 <sup>nd</sup> Grade	350	500	1000+
3 <sup>rd</sup> Grade	375	500	1000+
4 <sup>th</sup> Grade	375	500	1000+

Parents are encouraged to enter reading minutes into system each night by 8:00pm.

If you are unable to log minutes online each evening, we ask that you please make sure to enter the week's minutes by 8:00pm each Friday. Students will be awarded prizes based on minutes read and logged. Please contact the school office or your student's classroom teacher if you do not have internet access.

#### Prizes!

Students have many opportunities to earn prizes. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

##### Bronze Medal Goal:

Meet Grade Level Reading Goal: All who meet their first grade level reading goal will receive a prize. Students who meet their first grade level reading goal will also be entered into a drawing for a special prize; 1 winner drawn per grade.

##### Silver Medal Goal:

All students who meet their second "silver medal" grade level reading goal will receive a prize. Silver Medal readers will also be entered into a drawing for a special prize; 2 winners drawn per grade.

##### Gold Medal Goal:

Go for GOLD! Read 800-1000 minutes or more (depending on grade) to earn a special surprise experience with Mr. Herlache!

##### Top Readers:

The top reader from each grade will win a prize.

##### Top Classrooms:

The top class from each grade with the most minutes read receive an extra recess, and a special prize for the teachers too!

##### Completed BINGO cards:

Students who complete BINGO by March 10th will be entered into a drawing. All squares must be completed to be eligible for a prize! 1 winner per grade will be chosen to receive a special prize. \*\*BINGO cards will be sent home Monday, February 23rd\*\*

##### School Reading Goal:

If our school reads 150,000 minutes, we *all* earn reading time with Charlee and a prize!
